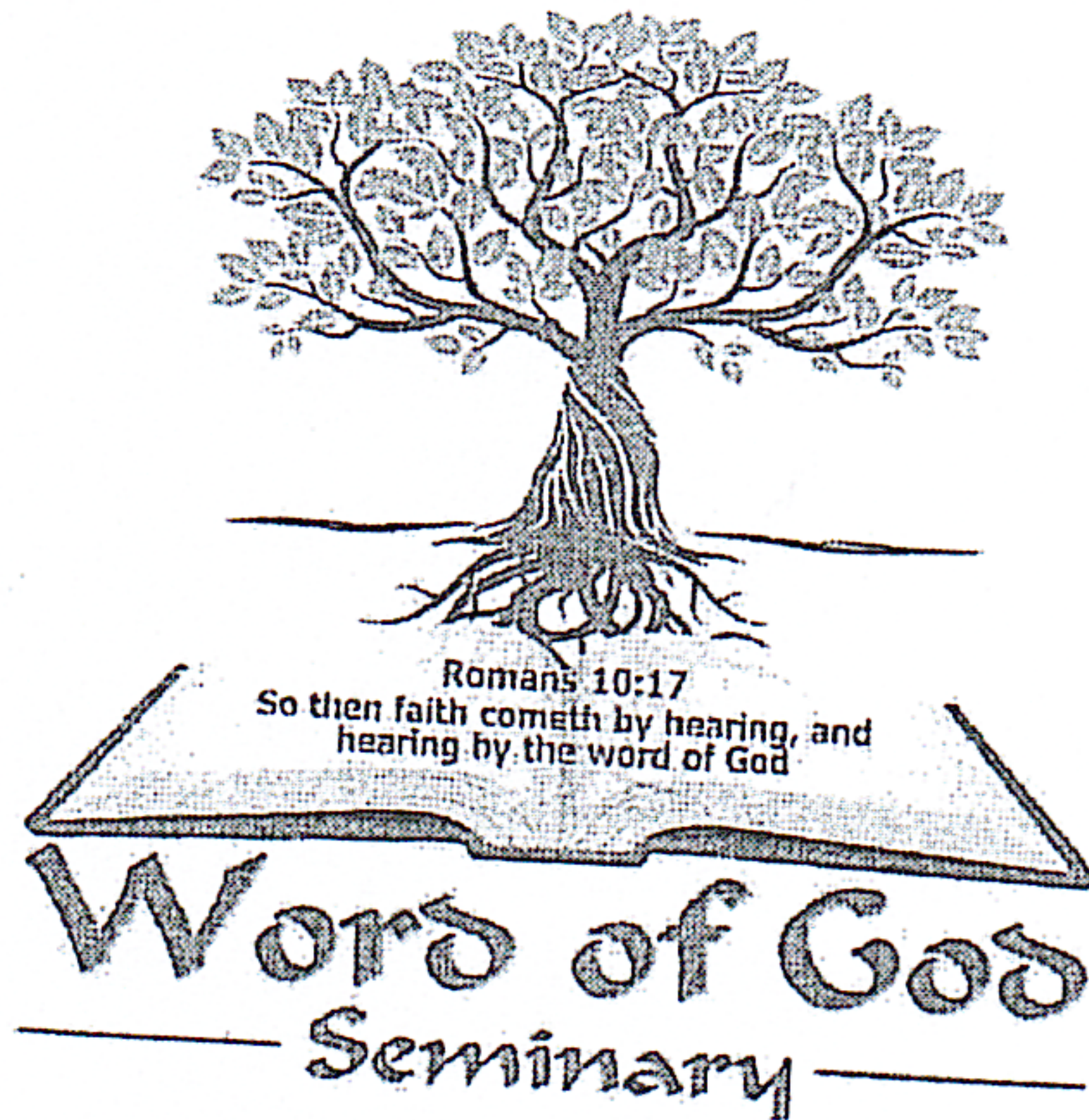

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERTAKING

Between

Word of God Seminary (WoGS)

And

Chaplaincy SA

Agreed to on this 3rd day of November 2025

1. Purpose

This Memorandum of Undertaking (MoU) sets forth the terms of strategic partnership between the Chaplaincy SA and Word of God Seminary (WoGS), both operating in South Africa, to promote WOGS'S accredited theological and ministry training programs to CHAPLAINCY SA's membership base and affiliated partners. The shared mission is to equip individuals to effectively spread the Word and advance Kingdom work through sound biblical education.

2. Scope and Collaboration

CHAPLAINCY SA agrees to:

- Promote WoGS courses, programs and events through its communication channels, including newsletters, social media and partner engagements.
- Facilitate introductions and referrals to WoGS for prospective students and ministry leaders.
- Support awareness campaigns that highlight the value proposition of WoGS's training offerings.

WoGS agree to:

- Provide Chaplaincy SA with updated program information, promotional materials and access to faculty or representatives for engagement purposes.
- Offer preferential access or discounts to CHAPLAINCY SA member where applicable.
- Recognize Chaplaincy SA as an official promotional partner.

3. Legal Nature of MoU

This MoU is a non-binding agreement that outlines the intentions of both parties to collaborate in good faith. It does not constitute a legal partnership, joint venture or agency relationship. Any future binding commitments shall be subject to separate written agreements.

4. Protection of Personal Information (POPIA Compliance)

Both parties commit to full compliance with the Protection of Personal Information Act (POPIA) of South Africa. Specifically:

- No personal data shall be shared between parties without prior written consent from the data subject.
- Any data shared shall be used solely for the purposes outlined in the MoU and handled securely.
- Each party shall maintain appropriate safeguards to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure or misuse of personal information.

5. Duration and Termination

This MoU shall remain in effect for a period of 12 months from the date of signing and may be renewed upon mutual agreement. Either party may terminate this MoU with 30 days written notice.

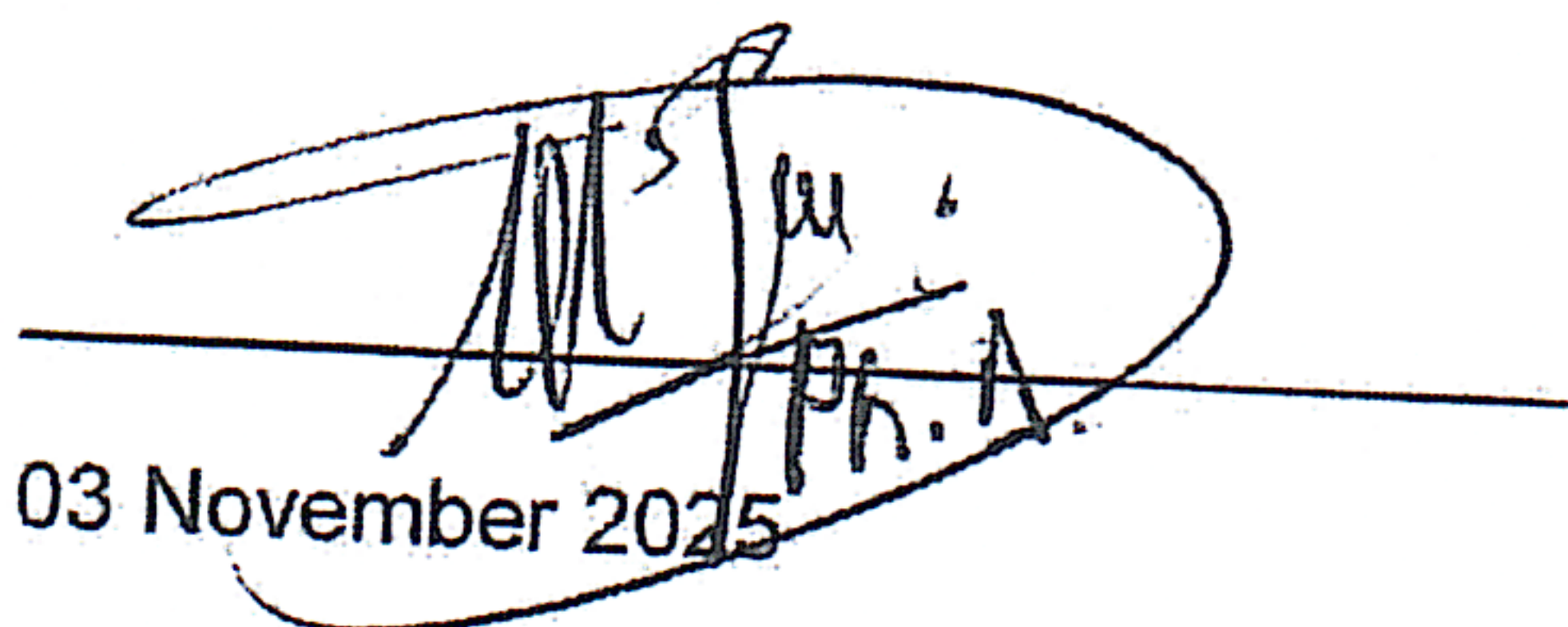

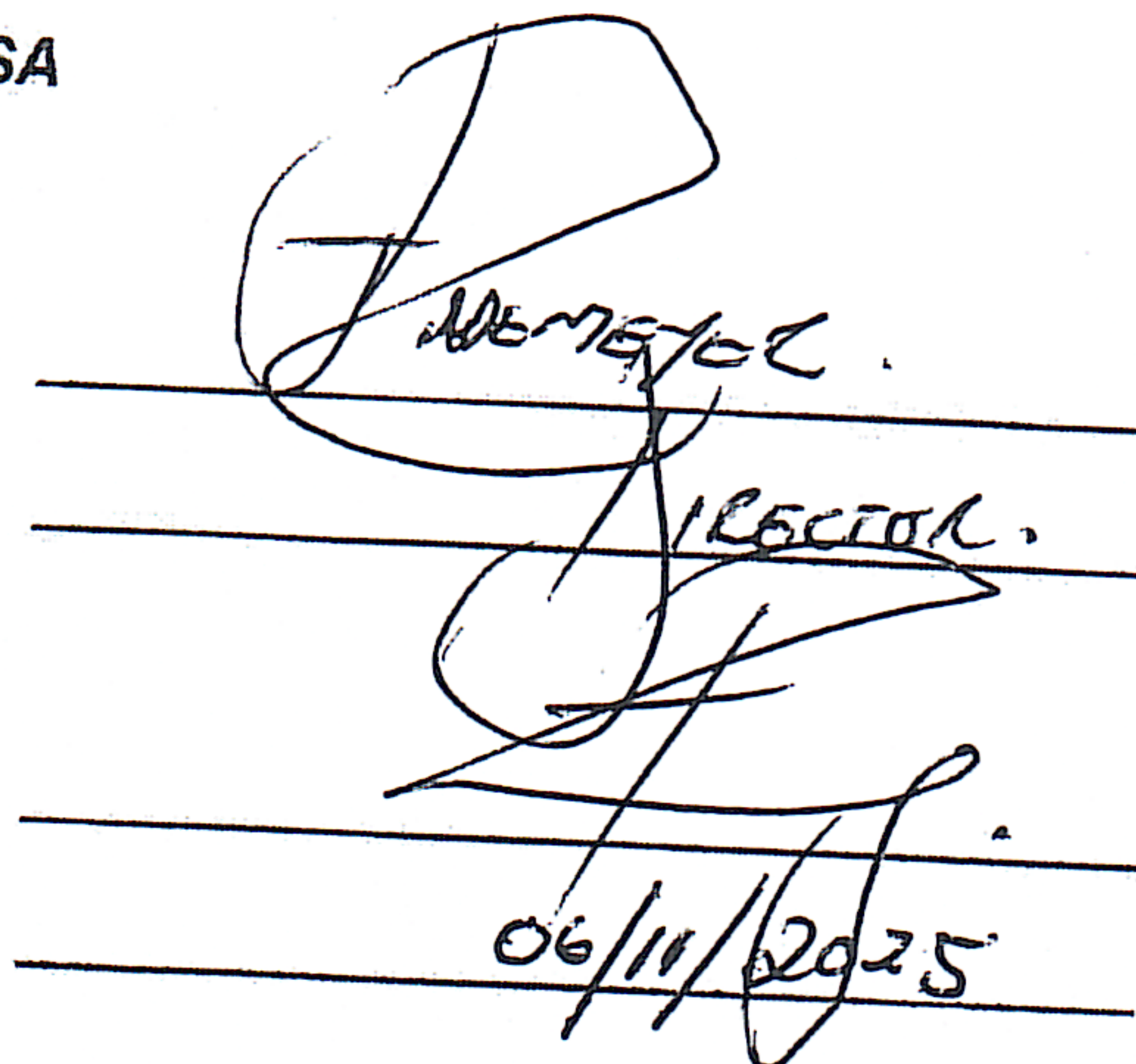
